Flag Day: The June 14th holiday commemorates the same day in 1777 when the Second Constitutional Congress adopted the thirteen-stripes-and-thirteen-stars flag.

The stars were put on a blue field, representing a new constellation in the night sky.

In 1914, President Woodrow Wilson dubbed June 14 "Flag Day". In 1949, Congress passed legislation asking the president to issue an annual proclamation calling for the observance of the holiday.

Federal government buildings are asked to fly the Stars and Stripes on Flag Day.

The week in which June 14 falls is National Flag Week, and citizens are encouraged to fly the flag that week.
